Midland University Heritage Arboretum Mission

The Midland University Heritage Arboretum is located on the campus of Midland University in Fremont, NE, USA. Fremont is located approximately 30 miles northwest of downtown Omaha, NE and approximately 50 miles north of Lincoln, the Nebraska State Capital. Fremont lies in the flood plain of the Platte River which flows the entire length of the state. Fremont is protected from major flooding by Union Dike and there is less than five feet of elevation change across the entire Midland campus. There are over 650 trees in the collection and a great variety of species on order to maintain a high degree of biodiversity.
